BLOCK 8 NEW YORK BEAUTY



The pattern will print in 4 pages and must be taped together to get the 12.5 inch <u>unfinished</u> block. Use the picture above for the proper order of the pattern pages.

IMPORTANT – when printing, make sure you set your printer to actual size – do not let the printer resize the pattern. There is also a 1-inch mark on the first page to check you scale after printing.

Remember the basic block is 12 inches. Line A is the 12" finished size. Line B is the 12.5" unfinished size and includes the ¼ inch seam allowance – do not cut this line off when you trim your pattern sections. Don't worry about the heavy black lines (Line A) being a smidge beyond 12 inches. This will take care of itself when you trim the final block.

The 12 inch block outline does not come to the edge of the inner pages – this is where you make sure the black lines meet when you put the 4-pieces together.

Once you piece your block together you will work with this pattern in 3 sections. After separating the sections be sure to add your ¼ inch seam allowance to all sides prior to piecing

Section 1 - the base - the bottom right hand corner

Section 2 – the crown – the center section

This section is paper piecing – piece in the order numbered for best results.

Section 3 – the arc – the background

This section can be folded in half to cut from a folded piece of fabric.

Piece all sections together.

Trim the block to 12.5 inches.


